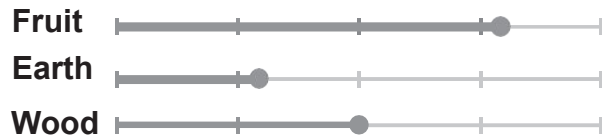


2018 Porter & Plot Cabernet Sauvignon

Paso Robles, CA

Winemaker Notes

By focusing on small-lot wines, Porter & Plot® showcases the unique, nuanced individuality of California's most exceptional vineyards and appellations. The 2018 Paso Robles Cabernet experienced late rainfall, heavy mid-summer winds, and a six-week heatwave through mid-August. This was followed by cool weather and a long extended harvest. Once harvested, the grapes are fully de-stemmed and fermented in a closed-top tank with pump overs occurring once a day. Once the wine fermented to 5 brix it was pressed off of its skins and allowed to finish fermentation in a stainless steel vessel. Post fermentation the wine was aged in 40% new French oak for 18 months. The resulting wine is rich with plummy fruit notes and a hint of dried herbs for complexity and smooth tannins.
